- a. a valid passport issued by or on behalf of an authority recognised by the Government;
- b. a national identity card issued by the authorities of the country;
- c. a document issued by or on behalf of an authority recognised by the Irish Government, which establishes the identity and nationality of the person to whom the document relates;
- d. A driving licence
